New MenB Vaccination Service for Community Pharmacies



Community pharmacies will begin delivering a new MenB vaccination service from late July 2026. The programme is aimed at Year 13 students and under-25s entering university or residential further education for the first time.

Eligible patients will receive two doses of the vaccine to help protect against Meningococcal B disease ahead of the autumn term. The service has been introduced in response to a recent increase in MenB cases in England, with around one million young people expected to be eligible.

Expanded Children's Flu Vaccination Advanced Service (October 2026)

From 1 October 2026, community pharmacies in England will be able to provide an expanded Children's Flu Vaccination Advanced Service following agreement with NHS England.

Key changes include:

- The existing service for 2- and 3-year-olds will continue.
- The service is being expanded to include:
 - Clinically at-risk children aged 2 years to under 18 years.
 - School-aged children (Reception to Year 11) who missed their vaccination at school (available from 1 December 2026).

Payment:

- Pharmacies will receive £10.06 per vaccination, increased from £9.58 in 2025/26.
- Funding comes from NHS vaccination budgets, not the Community Pharmacy Contractual Framework budget.

Service Aims:

- Increase flu vaccination uptake among children.



- Support GP practices by vaccinating clinically at-risk children.
- Provide catch-up opportunities for school-aged children who missed vaccination through the School Aged Immunisation Service.

Vaccine Supply:

- Most eligible children will receive the live attenuated influenza vaccine (LAIV) nasal spray, supplied centrally to pharmacies.

Additional eligible cohort added to adult flu vac service

The [amendment to the national flu letter](#) also announces the inclusion of a new eligible cohort of patients for the adult flu vaccination service later this year – people aged 16 years and over experiencing homelessness. This is defined as “rough sleepers and those using homeless hostels or night-shelters, rather than the broader definitions of homelessness”.

This addition to the eligible cohorts follows JCVI advice to the Government in June 2024. NHS England will issue further guidance on the addition of this cohort in due course.

Advice published for newly qualified prescribing pharmacists

The General Pharmaceutical Council (GPhC) has published advice for newly qualified prescribing pharmacists, ahead of the first cohort joining the register as independent prescribers from summer 2026.

The advice is aimed at pharmacists who have completed their MPharm under the 2021 initial education and training standards and will join the register as pharmacist independent prescribers. It highlights key considerations to support safe and effective prescribing from the outset, including:

- working within individual scope of practice;
- seeking appropriate support and mentorship;
- making prescribing decisions in the best interests of patients; and
- maintaining appropriate indemnity cover and engaging with revalidation.

The publication of the GPhC advice comes as [independent prescribing](#) is due to be introduced into the Community Pharmacy Contractual Framework (CPCF) in 2026/27 as an extension of Pharmacy First and the Pharmacy Contraception Service from autumn 2026.

The 2026/27 National Cardiovascular Disease Prevention (CVDP) Lipid Point of Care Testing (PoCT) Community Pharmacy Pilot, led by Barts Health NHS Trust.

The pilot supports lipid testing in community pharmacies to help identify cardiovascular risk earlier and improve prevention and treatment outcomes.
